

Our passion is people. We create from the heart with eternal gratitude. What is important to us?



Please do not arrive after gates are closed you, will not be granted entry until gates open again the next day.

NO FIRES ON SITE

This includes:

- Open fires
- Fire toys & props
- Fireworks
- Cigarette butts on the ground
- please bring a container to put them in
- Wood or charcoal BBQ's
- Kerosine Cookers
- No generators please
- You can bring a gas cooker but you must bring a table to sit it on. No gas cookers on the ground.

NO GLASS PAST THE GATE

- We will check your vehicle for glass upon entry
- Please bring plastic or cans
- Decant anything that comes in glass into a plastic bottle.

NO PETS ALLOWED ON FESTIVAL SITE

- You will be asked to leave immediately should you turn up with a pet.
- Our festival site is a working deer farm and the deer, turkeys and chickens are tolerant of us however they won't accept your pets and neither will we.

NO DRIVING ON FESTIVAL SITE


- Once you have parked near your campsite you will not be able to move your vehicle.
- If you need to leave before the 2nd of January please let the gate and parking team know and they will park you in Early Leaver's parking area.

NO SOUND SYSTEMS OR NOISY PARTIES IN THE CAMPGROUND

- We have four epic stages with a huge selection of music on them. Do your partying at the stages and keep the campground for sleeping and chilling.
- Sound systems will be confiscated.

CONSENT

WE'RE BIG ON CONSENT AT AUM

What is consent?

- If you don't receive an enthusiastic YES! Then it's a NO! That's your time to walk away and find something else that's fun to do.

IMBIBING

IMBIBE RESPONSIBLY

- AUM does not have licensed bars. You may bring your own providing you don't bring glass.
- AUM is not a piss-up. If you get obviously intoxicated you will stand out. Someone from our team will have a polite word with you and you may be asked to leave.
- Please check out the Mocktail Bar next to the Hub Stage (circus tent) where you can purchase non alcoholic mocktails and soft drinks
- Be smart with your imbibing. Know Your Stuff will be on site running drug checking clinics, please visit them.

Safe imbibing is smart imbibing!

ZERO WASTE

LEAVE NO TRACE

AUM is a Zero Waste event.

- That means that you are responsible for your own rubbish.
- Please bring some rubbish bags so that you can separate your recycling and rubbish and take it home with you.
- There will not be bins provided for your waste.
- We care for the land/whenua that we are lucky enough to use for AUM, please do your bit and treat it with the respect it deserves.
- Please don't be afraid to gently call someone out if you see them littering. This is your HOME for your stay.

AUM is often described as feeling safe and friendly. That's because of you and how you behave. Thank you ❤️


- Look after your mates, buddy up so you've always got someone when you need them.

THINGS TO DO!

MAKE SURE THAT YOU BRING THE FOLLOWING WITH YOU:



- **ID** - It will be checked at the gate
- **Your ticket** - Downloaded to your phone or printed before you leave home
- **Rubbish bags** - For rubbish and recycling
- Tent / Van/ Camper
- Bedding
- **A table** - if you're bringing a gas cooker
- **A torch** - our festival site is large and is not lit across the whole site
- Portable ashtray container
- **Reusable water bottle** - We have FREE drinking water available for you on site and you need to stay hydrated!
- **Warm clothes** - it can get cold in the early hours
- Comfortable shoes
- Hat
- Waterproof clothing or jacket
- **Toiletries and towels** - please use environmentally friendly products at AUM
- Sunscreen
- Ear plugs if you need them
- **Snacks** - good for keeping your energy levels up! That means more dancing!
- Any medication that you may need
- **Dress Ups!** We love a good costume at AUM and you will be in good company 😊



THINGS TO KNOW!

ACCESSIBILITY

- AUM is situated on sloping farmland with a sand base and access can be difficult.
- If you have a physical disability please make contact before the festival to discuss the site terrain and camping/other details

BE PREPARED

- AUM is an all weather event, sometimes it's really hot and sometimes it get's a bit cold and sometimes it's raining.
- Prepare for all weather!

FOOTWEAR

- Many of us prefer bare feet when playing on the paddock. We recommend you bring some comfortable shoes or jandals as there is quite a lot of Onehunga Prickles this year.

CAMPING

- Please be considerate with your space and nestle in close to your neighbours. Space is limited and we may ask you to move or reduce your footprint if you've spread out.
- **A good tip:** if a spot is suitable for a tent, then please don't park there. You'll be asked to move if you do.
- If you bring a caravan, you will likely get asked to move your towing vehicle to parking to save camping space.
- Follow the lead of our parking team who will help you with where you can camp.

PARKING

- There is parking in the camp zone only a few mins away from your camp.
- Once parked you will not be able to drive your car until the 2nd of January unless you park in **'Early Leavers'** parking.
- Please follow the guidance of our parking team to ensure that you park in the right spot.

CARPOOLING

- Carpool to save on fuel costs and save space at our festival site, and keep our neighbours happy.
- Check out our Facebook page for rides wanted/offered

CHILDREN

There are children of all ages at AUM

- Please be mindful of them and take care to show them how adults can have fun, responsibly.
- We ask that you have your children away from the stages by 10.00pm at night.
- Please bring hearing protection for them, festival can be loud.
- Under 18s must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.

DEER & OTHER CREATURES

- Deer and other creatures live on the land so please put your food away in the evening. They will come to your campsite and nibble on anything left out, including your rubbish!
- If they eat your rubbish, they get sick. Please keep your site clean and tidy.
- DO NOT TOUCH the baby deer. Their mother may reject them if you do. Please love all of the animals on the festival site from a distance.



DRIVING TO THE FESTIVAL

- Wilson Road is gravel. This creates a dust nuisance for our neighbours.
- Please drive slowly on Wilson Road to keep the dust down.
- Stay to the left and keep your noise to a minimum. No stereos or stopping to look at animals.
- Our neighbours are awesome and deserve to be respected and considered.

LOCAL AMENITIES

- Parakai is your last port of call when heading to the festival.
- The Parakai shops have lots of stuff you might need - Four Square, a bakery and other stores - and they are lovely.
- Why not support local businesses on your way to the festival?

FIRE

Don't forget:

- Put your gas cooker on a table.
- Put your cigarette butts in a container, do not drop them on the ground.
- Wood or charcoal type BBQs are not permitted
- Leave your fireworks at home.
- Don't use your fire toys without prior approval.
- If you see someone doing something dangerous please let us know. We will have a quiet chat and ensure that they understand what not to do.
- If you do see a fire please clear the area (yelling "Fire, Fire!" works) and alert a crew member immediately.
- You can always find crew at the Information Station, Gate, Safety Zone and at all Stages. Our Security Guards will be around the campgrounds as well.

MEDICAL

- If you need medical help we have on-site medics available at any hour. They're in the Safety Zone in the main camping area - look for the medics flags and ambulance

EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT

- Emergency equipment is located all around the festival site. Please see the Site Map for extinguisher and fire blanket locations.
- They can be found at all stages and zones.
- Sand is a great fire extinguisher too and we are surrounded in it.
- Please do not attempt to put out a fire unless it is safe to do so. Find a Crew Member and they will be able to assist.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- Remain Calm.
- Our crew are trained to respond to all manner of emergencies and will assist you.
- Follow their instructions.

EVACUATION

- In the unlikely event of an evacuation alert, immediately walk to the closest Muster Station. You can find these on the Site Map.
- Await Instruction from a Crew Member.
- Please follow all instructions from Crew Members.
- Do not return to your campsite or your vehicle until the all clear is given.

MEDICAL

- In an emergency please ask the nearest crew member for assistance.
- At the stages you will see our security wearing Hi Viz vests, they are very approachable and always happy to help.
- If you can't find a crew member please head to the Safety Zone to find assistance. If you need medical help, look out for the medics flags and Ambulance in the main camping area

SECURITY

- Our security team are trained to help and to keep you safe. They're also lovely, if you have a security issue, let them know, they will have your back!
- You are responsible for the security of your campsite and your belongings, please take care of your stuff.
- If you think that you need security assistance please find the nearest crew member and they will be able to help you.

LOST CHILD/PERSON

- If you're missing someone important please let us know by going directly to the Information Station. We have procedures in place to assist you.
- If you've lost your very important small person, please head to the Information Station. If we have found them, that's where they will be and if we haven't found them then we soon will.

NO CELLPHONE OR WIFI SERVICE ON SITE

- AUM is a no cell or wifi site. It's such a treat to come and unwind without the outside world for three days. Enjoy!
- Please let you loved ones know that you will be out of reception for the duration of your festival so that they don't worry when they can't reach you.
- If you need to make an emergency call, please go to the Information Station

ZONES, STAGES & SPECIAL EVENTS

INFORMATION STATION

- Got a question? Info is open 24 hours for the duration of the festival. They are your go to for any queries that you may have.
- They also run a shop that sells basic supplies, things that you may have forgotten or lost.
- Go and ask them a random question and see if they really do know everything!

Safety Zone

- Our on-site medics are there to assist you. Look for the medical tent in the Safety Zone. They are there
- **Haven** is our Safe Space. There you will find a team of people that are trained to hold space for you, whether you're feeling vulnerable, overwhelmed, anxious or just in need of a friendly face.
- Look out for the roaming **Space Patrol** team in purple vests who are dedicated to ensuring that you're having a great time and are feeling comfortable and safe.
- The **Know Your Stuff** tent offers a confidential drug checking service. and can tell you if what you've got is what you think it is. They also have info on what's out there that is not good, what's out there that is too good so you know to take less. The Know Your Stuff team are a wealth of knowledge and are keen to share it with you so don't hesitate to get in there and have a chat with the team. Look out for their smiley face logo.

WHITE STAG STAGE

If you're up for epic lighting, visual décor, sound design and an eclectic mix of genres then this is the stage for you!

HUB STAGE

The Hub is where you will find; Live bands, DJs and Performance, including the Midnight Cabaret (R18) and the Gala Show (PG) among a host of other tidbits.


